<u>Scouts</u>	Take on the Waterfront trail or Cullen Park Trail north to Heber Down
<u>Venturers</u>	Meet at Julie Payette School (400 Garden Street, Whitby) Community Service School hours for all attendees

Moving forward, all sections have a community service/Earth badge that can be given out as part of one adventure that is needed to get that badge.

Road and Trail helps towards these badges in all sections. For example, Beavers get a North Star award and need 5 community hours and they have a big project to do. Environmental clean up can help with this. Cubs need 15 hours of service towards the Seonee Award and Scouts need 30 hours towards the Chief Scout Award.

Different ways to participate in Road and Trail are to clean up around your meeting space, or when you go for hikes as a group (meeting night or weekend) or when you are out camping somewhere. Then please take a picture of your group and your bags of garbage and post it on your Facebook group page. Be careful of youth who do not wish their photo taken!

If you wish to get a crest from the Scout Shop for your group, there are several crests to choose from.
