DESCRIPTION

Our Annual Pow Wow Camp this year is designed to give all registered members a boost towards the new Canadian Path programing.

Some of the events include:

- Fire Building and Safety (W/ Bannock)
- Emergency Aid Skills: First Aid (Kit making), Emergency Preparedness
- Camping Skills: Tent Set-up Relay and Packing Camp Gear Relay
- Trailmaking/Hiking
- The Path Map Game.

And for the Leaders, the Path Map Game should be of extra interest, as the goal here is to help you with the primary planning for the year ahead by getting the information on what interests our youth!

And once again, along with Akela's Bone being awarded for the best weekend score for the groups, the Silly Putty Award will be awarded to the Scouter showing the most participation and enjoyment!

Scouters may arrive at 4:00 pm to begin set-up. Youth should not be arriving until 6:30/7:00 pm (fully fed). This should give ample time for Scouters to unload any gear in vehicles not remaining at the camp site and to be parked in a designated parking area nearby.

Friday night there should be a gathering game if possible, or at the very least a Friendship Campfire will be held at Beaver Meadow, following a camp opening at approx: 8:30/9:00 pm Lights out, mug up etc is at the discretion of the group Scouters.

Saturday programing will begin about 8:30 am with Opening. Lunch will be around 12:30 to 1:30-ish. The days events should be over by 5:00/5:30 pm. Formal Camp Fire should begin around 8/8:30 and last no more than 40 mins, at which time once we break formal the youth and Scouters can return to enjoy the remainder of the fire.

Sunday Morning shall begin again around 8:30/9:00-ish, with a Hiking /Trail making/Trail safety session with staggered start times that will lead into Scouts own hopefully by 11:00 for no more than 30 mins. Closing should be at 12:00 latest for 10 to 15 mins for awards and Pick up of youth by 12:30.

7. If your pack is twinning with another pack or you are sharing camping equipment, please send in with your registration package, a request (in writing) that you wish to camp together.
8. There will be potable water at the site.
9. Special Needs Individuals (wheel chair): All special needs requirements will be dealt with individually. Please make us aware of these youth and adults with your registration package.
10. No-Trace Camping will be required – Groups must leave the campsites cleaner than when you arrive, and you are required to take away all of your own garbage.
