- 5. Receipts will be delivered to you at Cuboree.
- 6. The designated contact Leader is responsible for ensuring that only registered members are enrolled as participants.
- 7. This facility is a Scouts Canada property and not generally open to the public. There may be however, other Groups/Areas in the park. Security teams and protocols will be in place to keep all attendees safe.
- 8. There are no picnic tables available on site.
- 9. If your pack is twinning with another pack or you are sharing camping equipment, please note this on your registration package need to Twin with "Pack name and #"
- 10. Water is in limited supply, be sure to bring potable water.
- 11. Campfires are strictly prohibited.
- 12. **Special Needs Cases**: All special needs cases will be dealt with individually. *Please make us aware of these cases with your registration package*. This should include functional and cognitive disabilities, and special medical requirements.
- 13. No-Trace Camping will be required Groups must leave the campsites cleaner than when you arrive, and you are required to take away all of your own garbage.
- 14. Busses leave at 6:00 pm from the Whitby Operations Center.

 Overnight parking is available in a specific lot. Please indicate the number of vehicles that will be left overnight in Whitby. Specific details will be provided at the Leaders Meeting in May.
- 15. Estimated time of return is 4:30-5:00 pm.
- 16. It is MANDATORY that a leader goes on the bus with the youth (Each pack must be in compliance with ratio as required by Scouts Canada at all times.)
- 17. When this camp is over, each Cub may have the requirements for activity badges. It will be the responsibility of the packs to make arrangements to acquire and present these badges.

NOTES:

- 1. Our team strongly recommends your pack have a "**Get Ready for Camp**" night. Instructing cubs and parents on proper packing techniques is crucial. Cubs will have to identify and carry all personal gear to their campsite.

 *Please refrain from using plastic garbage bags as they are easily destroyed in the truck packing process.
- All of the youth should have all of their gear clearly and BRIGHTLY marked with name and pack id (for example: neon duct tape with pack number). It may be dusk when we are unpacking the truck.
