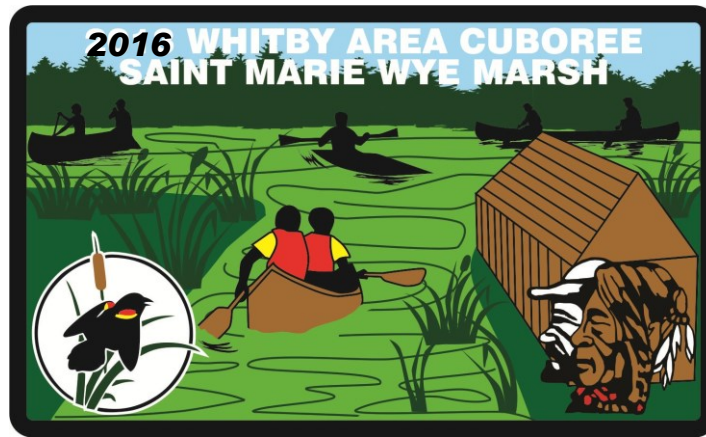

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Write or print clearly, legibly, and neatly!
2. Complete all applicable sections (It's suggested that you keep a photocopy)
3. Attach originals to your Group Committee (or equivalent) cheque payable to **Scouts Canada Whitby Area**
4. Forward the package, by mail, to:

5. Receipts will be delivered to you at Cuboree.
6. The designated contact Leader is responsible for ensuring that only registered members are enrolled as participants.
7. This facility will be open to the public while we are at all of the events. For ease of identification all youth and leaders are required to wear their necker at all times.
8. Since each youth will have a chance to paddle a canoe for some time, each is asked to bring with them a paddle and a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) that must be CSA Approved. Each PFD & Paddle **must be clearly marked with the owners name and the Group name.**
9. There are no picnic tables available on site. Plan accordingly.
10. If your pack is twinning with another pack or you are sharing camping equipment, please note this on your registration package - need to Twin with "Pack name and #"
11. Water is in limited supply, be sure to bring potable water.
12. Campfires are strictly prohibited.
13. **Special Needs Cases:** All special needs cases will be dealt with individually.
Please make us aware of these cases with your registration package.
14. No-Trace Camping will be required – Groups must leave the campsites cleaner than when you arrive, and you are required to take away all of your own garbage.
15. Busses leave at 6:00 pm from the Whitby Operations Center.
Overnight parking is available in a specific lot. Please indicate the number of vehicles that will be left overnight in Whitby. Specific details will be provided at the Leaders Meeting in May.
16. Estimated time of return is 4:30-5:00 pm on Sunday May 29 2016.
17. It is **MANDATORY** that a leader goes on the bus with the youth (Each pack must be in compliance with ratio as required by Scouts Canada at all times.)
18. When this camp is over, each Cub will have filled all of the requirements for his/her Canoeist badge and Naturalist badge. It will be the responsibility of the packs to make arrangements to acquire and present these badges.

NOTES:

1. Our team strongly recommends your pack have a "**Get Ready for Camp**" night. Instructing cubs and parents on proper packing techniques is crucial. Cubs will have to identify and carry all personal gear to their campsite. Contact Beth McWhorter if you need help with this.
Please refrain from using plastic garbage bags as they are easily destroyed in the truck packing process.
2. All of the youth should have all of their gear clearly and BRIGHTLY marked with name and pack id (for example: ON neon duct tape). It may be dusk when we are unpacking the truck.
3. Use 2" masking tape to CLEARLY identify PFD's and Paddles.

Paddles and PFD's will be shared by everyone. They will be collected and stored in locked storage at the waterfront area)
