**Note:**

Each group is to have a self-contained camp site with all tents, shelters, food and equipment as needed to maintain the camp. Volunteers need to be screened, according to the rules in Scouts Canada Bylaws, Policies and Procedures (BP&P). All youth and Scouters need to be fully registered at the time of the camp.

Please have on hand registration forms or certificate of physical fitness for all campers, in case of a Zombie emergency.

Cars are not allowed in the camping area after 6:00pm Friday or before 2:00pm Sunday, so pack like you need to carry your gear 10 min from the parking lot, since you will.

After the apocalypse there will be no gas for your car anyway, so it is good practice.
