Commissioner's Cup

To be presented to the group that best promotes scouting in the community
The decision on the commissioner's cup will be done by the Area Commissioner.

Group Committee Award

The decision on the Group Committee Award will be done by the Area Executive and the Honours and Award team.

Adult volunteer awards

Whitby Area has created these awards to recognize Adult volunteers; this does not include activity leaders or scouters in training. The awards and the definitions or criteria are as follows:

Loyalty to Scouting

Assists in or runs a Whitby area event or activity outside of their primary role or position

Long Service

Presented for long service to Scouting
Criteria: That the service years be as a registered adult member, continuous service is not required.

Commitment to Scouting

Delivery of outstanding program to the youth

Front Line Scouter Award

For service solely and directly at the youth level

Any registered adult member can be nominated for any or all of these awards. The final decision will be up to the honours and awards committee.

Youth member awards

Spirit of Scouting Youth Award

This award is presented to a youth member who demonstrates their devotion to Scouting by living the Scout Law whether in or out of uniform, and who contributes much to the youth and the programs
