

Camp Samac Shooting Competition for Scouts, Venturers & Rovers

Troop shoot is **open to any registered member** of Scouts Canada or Guiding (never come) who is registered as a Scout or above (Guiding same level as Scouts).

Date: **Saturday April 6, 2013**. Usual start 9:00 a.m. – normally 7 lanes at a time. Uniforms optional.

Cost is \$4.00 and for that participants will receive a shooting time to fire 20 shots at 2 targets.

The **shooting times will be pre-booked** for a total 20 minute period and each group should show up at least 15 minutes prior to the shooting time. People who do not pre-book shooting times will have to wait for an opening.

The targets will be scored and from the scores they may qualify for rewards.

There are 4 categories of awards:

1. **Troop team – Scouts** from a group can form teams of 3 (to be determined before shooting) and their scores will count toward the team category. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will receive an award. 1st will have the names on the trophy displayed outside the range.
2. **Single youth** – individual **Scouts or a team** that does not qualify for the top 3. Their scores will count toward the single category. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will receive an award. 1st will have their name on the trophy displayed outside the range.
3. **Senior Youth** – It is open to all **Venturers and Rovers under the age of 20**. Their scores will count toward the senior youth category. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will receive an award. 1st will have their name on the trophy displayed outside the range.
4. **Leaders** – All **Rovers age 20 and over** and all registered adults. Their scores will count toward the senior youth category. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will receive an award. 1st will have their name on the trophy displayed outside the range.

The start time is usually 9:00 a.m. and awards presentations are 3:30 to 4:00 p.m.
