**Waterfront Trail** - 12th A and B, 4th, 7th, and 1st Whitby Pack go to the starting point at the base of Thickson Rd. Collection could be east or west from that point.

**Scouts**     Mule Trail (12th troop and 7th Ventures), Scout trail (4th troop) and the northern portion of the scout trail is 12Venturers

**Venturers**     **Julie Payette Public School** on Garden Street just north of Mary Street. Collection is north along Garden St. Participants can get volunteer hours for high school.
